2010 Pilot project

 Collaborate - 2nd level school (12-18 years) in disadvantaged area of North Dublin & City of Dublin Vocational Education Committee

Aims of Project

- 1. To provide front-line support for young carers
- 2. To build support network of Young Carer
- To raise awareness of young carers in school and in community
- 4. To raise voices of young carers

Pilot Project

- No funding available for this project
- Shared our resources of personnel & experience
- Agreed working definition
- Gained consent parents
- Met with young carers in school to find out about their experiences and needs
- Awareness Day in school Workshops

Year 2

- 2011 City of Dublin Youth Services Board youth workers
- Weekly meetings with young carers
- All agencies continue to meet quarterly consultative role
- Project now integrated into school practice
