

Carer Strategy 2012 Actions on Young People with Caring Responsibilities


- 2.2.1 **Raise Awareness** and understanding among education providers of the signs
- 2.2.2 Encourage **statutory agencies** to **review the way that they respond**
- 2.2.3 **Identify support services needed** and **create mechanisms** for young carers to contact service providers
- 2.2.4 **Investigate and analyse the situation** of children and young people undertaking caring roles




